

## **1. Background**

The Narragansett School System is soliciting proposals for a Physician/Consultant to work on an as-needed basis. The Narragansett School System (NSS) serves approximately 1200 students attending our 3 schools. The nursing staff consists of 3 school nurses working at our 3 schools.

## **2. Scope of Work & Key Deliverables**

The scope of work will include the following:

- Provide medical services for students having learning impairments as specified in the Regulations of the Board of Regents Governing the Education of Handicapped Children
- Review yearly all existing policies/procedures/standing orders pertaining to the health and welfare of students and staff in the district. Work in collaboration with the Nursing Staff in creating new policies/procedures/standing orders as needed.
- Work in collaboration with the Nursing Staff on matters regarding the exclusion and readmission of pupils for reasons of illness
- Work in collaboration with the Nursing Staff on matters dealing with crisis, emergencies and vital information, which relate to the health and safety of the students
- Provide physical examinations to students without identified health care providers
- Be available to address emergent and urgent issues that affect the health and welfare of students and staff in the district
- Meet with Nursing Staff regularly and as needed to provide consultation on health care and safety concerns

## **3. Required Qualifications**

NSS requires a vendor to meet the qualifications and specifications listed below.

- Must hold a valid license by the RI Health Department Division of Professional Regulation
- Must be local to Rhode Island or the greater Rhode Island area
